Honey

A thick, sweet liquid made from flower nectar by bees. It is yellow or brown.

Bee

An insect with a hairy body, four wings, and sometimes a stinger. Some kinds of bees live in social groups, and some live alone. Many bees drink nectar from flowers.

Pollen

The fine, yellow powder made by a flowering plant. When pollen is carried to another plant of the same kind, it fertilizes that plant's seeds.

Insect

A small animal whose body is divided into three parts. Insects also have three pairs of legs and usually one or two pairs of wings.

Seed

The small part of a flowering plant that grows into a new plant.

Flower

The part of a plant that has petals and that makes fruit or seeds; blossom.

Butterfly

An insect with four large wings. Butterflies are closely related to moths but have thinner bodies and are usually more brightly colored.

Garden

An area of land used for growing flowers or vegetables.

Pollinate

To move or carry pollen to a plant, causing the seeds to be fertilized.

Nectar

The sweet liquid a plant makes that attracts insects and birds.
